Why Should I Have A Will?

Part of Christian stewardship is planning for the future. If you don't plan now for what happens to your estate after you die, then someone else will do it for you! The "system" will take over, and one of the things it will do is to drain off a very large percentage of what was yours. When that happens, then any plans you had for helping the kingdom of God might be lost.

How Do I Include A Gift In My Will Or Trust For The Camp?

- Set amount: Specify a certain dollar amount.
- Percentage: This amount will fluctuate according to the size of your estate.
- Property: This could be real estate or personal property (jewelry, coin collection, vehicles, etc.)
- Residue: A gift that is left from your estate after other bequests are satisfied.

Note: There are many ways of naming the camp in your will or trust. Your attorney can provide you with the necessary details and wording.
